This November, Clackamas County residents will be presented with two ballot measures regarding Urban Renewal Districts. One would require voters within a proposed urban renewal district to approve its creation (3-388). The other (3-886) requires a county-wide vote for the establishment of an urban renewal district. Both measures would apply only to urban renewal districts in unincorporated Clackamas County. But why does it matter to you?

Burton Weast will give an overview of Urban Renewal Districts and how they work. County Commissioner Ann Lininger will be there to discuss Measure 3-388, and proponents of Measure 3-386 have been invited to attend. Much of the time will be spent on audience questions.
